Tsawwassen – Swartz Bay route:

- 6:00 am sailings from Swartz Bay to Tsawwassen daily
- Midnight sailings from Tsawwassen to Swartz Bay daily
- Additional sailings during the day on Fridays and Sundays to accommodate increased traffic to and from Vancouver Island

Horseshoe Bay – Departure Bay route:

- Midnight sailings from Horseshoe Bay to Departure Bay daily

Horseshoe Bay – Langdale route:

- 11:00 pm sailings from Horseshoe Bay to Langdale daily

“BC Ferries is pleased to offer these additional sailings so Olympic ticketholders and event participants can attend the festivities knowing they’ll get there on time and that they’ll get home at night,” said David L. Hahn, BC Ferries’ President and CEO. “There will be tremendous pressure on traffic and accommodations during the Games.
